

Yavapai Library Network Monthly Report



January 2026

Greetings,

This past month has been one of meaningful transition and strong forward momentum for the Yavapai Library Network. We continue to make significant progress in both our technical infrastructure and collaborative initiatives, and I'm pleased to share several key updates.

Recent Highlights

- **Annual & Digital Usage Reports:** After some brief delays, the FY25 Annual Report is officially live on the YLN website (<https://www.yln.info/ylN-annual-reports>). Additionally, I have prepared an FY22–FY25 OverDrive report (<https://www.yln.info/ylN-miscellaneous-reports>) for the Steering Committee, highlighting major trends and performance indicators. If you're interested in how your library is meeting the growing demand for e materials, these reports clearly illustrate the increased digital usage among our patrons.
- **A Warm Welcome to Our New Cataloger:** We are delighted to welcome Ginney Bilbray as our new YLN Cataloger. Many of you know Ginney from her long tenure as a librarian at Yavapai College. Her deep familiarity with our network and her extensive cataloging expertise make her an exceptional addition to the team. She has already settled in smoothly, and we look forward to her insight as we move into upcoming projects.
- **ERAU Departure:** As of January 30, the Embry Riddle Aeronautical University (ERAU) departure has been finalized. Items and accounts without outstanding fees have been successfully removed from Koha. A heartfelt thank you goes out to the public libraries that supported ERAU faculty, staff, and students throughout this transition. The YCFLD/YLN office will continue to accept any remaining "ERAU straggler" items that may arrive at your locations.
- **SkyRiver Implementation:** We have officially entered the implementation phase for SkyRiver. While recent shifts in the library vendor landscape have presented challenges, reaching this stage represents a major step forward for cataloging stability and long term efficiency.
- **Youth Services Update:** After a long hiatus, the Youth Services group reconvened for a productive meeting that included electing a new Chair and Recorder and sharing recent accomplishments from their libraries. Members committed to meeting three times per year—twice in person—to strengthen collaboration. This renewed engagement will be essential for resource sharing and enhancing youth programming across the network.
- **"Did You Know?" Section:** Please check out our new monthly report feature designed to offer quick insights into network processes and tools. This month's highlight focuses on transit routes. Additional details and tips can be found in the YLN portal.

Technical Enhancements & RFP Updates

- Automated Circulation Solutions RFP: The Automated Circulation Solutions RFP (formerly RFID & AMH) was released on January 27. The committee worked diligently to refine specifications and incorporate improvements. Proposals are due February 19. I am incredibly grateful for the time and expertise the committee members put into this project; the work is not yet done, but we have reached a major milestone.
- Student PIN & Sora Access Improvements: We've implemented a significant improvement to Sora access: students now only need their account number to log in, eliminating the PIN requirement. Additionally, we have restored our original nightly cron jobs to ensure student PINs—both visible and encrypted—reset correctly to their original values. This resolves the long standing encryption mismatch issues and provides a smoother login experience for all student accounts.

Looking Ahead

We are beginning to gather information for our first ever network wide solicitation for library materials and value added services. Our aim is to establish a cooperative agreement that any YLN library—and S.A.V.E. (Strategic Alliance for Volume Expenditures) members outside the network—can use. This initiative will streamline purchasing and technical services, reducing the need for individual solicitations or reliance on “piggyback” agreements.

Thank you all for your continued collaboration and dedication to our patrons. Please feel free to reach out to me or the team with any questions.

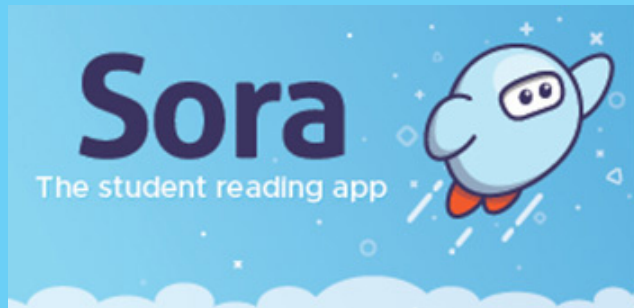

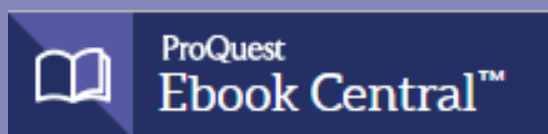

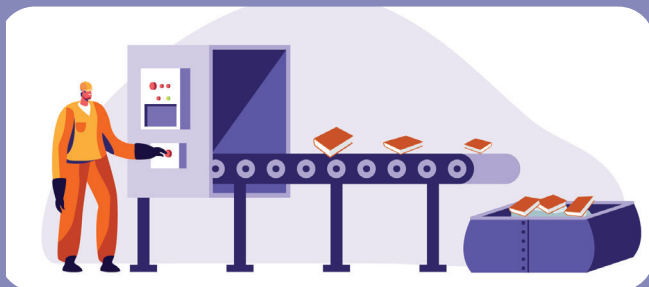
